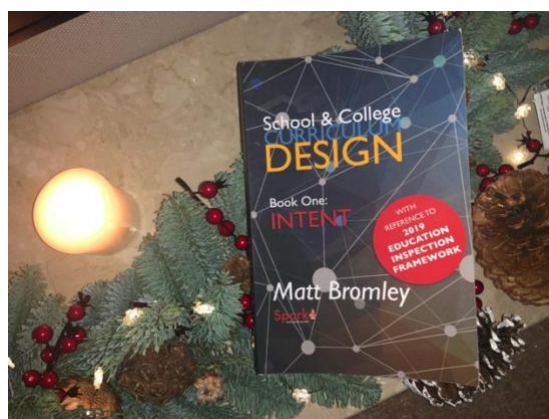
Whether you have a chocolate box Christmas or an alternative break, give yourself all the time you need, guilt free, with permission to prioritise you and those around you.
